



## 2016 Poster Contest Information & Guidelines



### “The Flea and the Professor”

**Entry Deadline: Friday, March 18, 2016 at 5:00 p.m.**

**Prize: \$250**

The poster will be used prior to, during, and after the festival. Additionally, it will be used as our annual theme- included placement on shirts, advertising, applications, etc. The 2016 Danish Festival will be held the third weekend of August- August 18-21, 2016.

1. There is no limit on the number of entries, but each entry must have the artist's name, address, and phone number on the back of the entry.
2. Types of work - original artwork in any medium. The artwork should include the theme in a creative but realistic interpretation. The artwork must not have been previously reproduced. The artwork will be digitally photographed.
3. Submissions of artwork: Artwork should be hand delivered to the Danish Festival Office located on the second floor of the Huntington Bank building prior to the deadline or mailed to P.O. Box 211, Greenville, Michigan 48838.
4. The finished artwork should be no smaller than 12 inches by 16 inches. The Danish Festival Committee reserves the right to modify the winning design in accordance with the printing process. They also reserve the right to not select any of the entries if all entries fail to meet the theme criteria.
5. The Danish Festival Committee cannot accept liability for damage or loss of any artwork, for any cause, while in their possession.
6. The Danish Festival Committee will display the contest entries at the Huntington Bank building April 8 through April 29, 2016.
7. The artwork chosen for the 2016 Danish Festival Poster becomes the property of the Danish Festival Committee.
8. The unveiling of the poster will be held in conjunction with the unveiling of the 2016 "The Flea and the Professor" mural, tentatively scheduled at 11 a.m., Friday, July 22, 2016. The unveiling is open to the public.
9. Winners will be notified by the Danish Festival office around April 6, 2016. All decisions will be final.
10. All entries need to be picked up by Aug. 5, 2016, at the Danish Festival office.
